- 1.1. That approval be given to acquire all necessary land interests (including the additional Plot 8) required to implement the proposed Scheme on detailed terms and conditions to be settled by the Director of Culture, Community and Business Services (Strategic Manager – Assets and Development)
- 1.2. That authority be given to commence the process for and the making of a Compulsory Purchase Order in respect of the revised land detailed within Appendix 1, as appropriate.
- 1.3. That delegated authority be given to the Director of Culture, Community and Business Services (Strategic Manager – Assets and Development) to amend the scope of the land detailed in Appendix 1 on the basis that it will not be extended, but it could be refined / minimised.

- 2.1. The acquisition of all necessary land interests are required to implement the Scheme within funding timescales identified with the Solent Local Enterprise Partnership.
