THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 ('the Regulations')

REGULATION 11 - KEY DECISIONS

Regulation 11 (cases of special urgency) allows for a key decision to be made if it is impracticable for notice of the intention to take a key decision under Regulations 9 or 10. Regulation 11 sets out the actions required to be taken in those circumstances which includes setting out the reasons for urgency.

The Executive Member for Environment and Transport intends to take a key decision on **Statutory Home to School Transport Services** at a meeting on Monday 21 March 2016 at 14:00 at The Castle, Winchester.

The report seeks the approval of the Executive Member for Environment and Transport on recommendations arising from a review of subsidised bus services that convey non-entitled pupils to schools.

Although this item was included in a previously published Forward Plan, a change to the Executive Member portfolio requires that the intention to take the decision is notified in accordance with Regulation 11. This matter is considered urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred. This decision needs to be taken on this date so as not to delay notification of the decision to Hampshire Schools.

In accordance with Regulation 11, the Chairman of the relevant Select Committee, Councillor Wheale, is in agreement that a decision that this matter may be considered.
