1 Purpose and Summary

- 1.1 The Anti Theft, Fraud and Corruption Strategy required updating to reflect the latest guidance from the Chartered Institute of Public Finance and Accountancy (CIPFA) and changes in roles and titles.
- 1.2 The attached revised Strategy shows tracked changes so that amendments to the existing Strategy can clearly be seen.
