Application assessment summary**

Each grant application has been assessed against the Culture and Community Activity Grant criteria (Appendix 1a) using a standard template.

Bassline Circus (Countywide project)	Carnival Arts for Winchester Groups (£5,546)	<p>Bassline Circus will teach young people aged 8-25 circus and carnival skills over three months to perform at Boomtown Fair in August 2016. In partnership with Naomi House, Winchester Gold, YMCA and Blue Apple Theatre it will aim to include young people in most need of cultural input including those with disabilities and socially isolated young people. The classes will include dance, theatre, circus and carnival acts, collaborating with professional and local artists to teach 50 young people.</p> <p>The application identifies partnership funding of £2,600 from Boomtown Fair.</p> <p>A partial award of £1,830 was agreed on 21 January 2016. When the application was assessed, the income for the project was overestimated. It has since been confirmed the only expected income is £2,600 from Boomtown Fair. In light of this, it is now recommended that the application is supported to the full amount requested.</p> <p>It is recommended that Bassline Circus is awarded £2,950.</p>	£2,946	£2,950 <i>(made up of £1,120 and £1,830 awarded on 21 January 2016)</i>
Horndean Community Association (East Hants / Catherington)	Ladies Shed Open Day (£3,000)	<p>Horndean Community Association seeks funding to support an Open Day on 1 May 2016 to promote its ongoing Ladies Shed project. 500 Hampshire residents are expected to benefit.</p> <p>The organisation has committed £150 of its own funds to the project and applied for £1,500 from East Hants District Council. The budget shortfall is £2,550. Councillor Harvey was consulted.</p> <p>The decision was deferred on 21 January 2016 as the organisation had not been able to submit all the required documentation. It was unsuccessful in an application for £2,711 Culture and Community Activity Grant (19/1/15) as the project did not fit scheme criteria.</p> <p>As the organisation has not submitted all the required supporting documents, it is recommended that this application is not supported.</p>		
Loud and Proud (Gosport)	Loud and Proud Volunteering in the Community (£2,330)	<p>Loud and Proud seeks funding to support a healthy eating project, intergenerational sessions and the costs of volunteering at civic events. 30 Hampshire residents are expected to benefit.</p> <p>The organisation had also applied to Awards for All for the full costs of this project. The decision was deferred on 21 January 2016 pending the outcome of this application. The organisation has since confirmed that the Awards for All application was successful so there is no project shortfall.</p> <p>All Gosport Councillors were consulted - Councillor Edgar, Carter and Burgess supported the original recommendation. Councillor Chegwyn expressed support for the organisation and a wish that they could be funded.</p> <p><u>Note:</u> The organisation was awarded four County Councillor Grants in 2015/16 with a combined value of £2,250.</p> <p>As there is no project shortfall, it is recommended that this application is not supported.</p>	£2,330	£0
