ACQUISITION OF LAND (AUTHORISATION PROCEDURE) ACT 1946

Extinguishment of Public Right of Way Over Eggar's New Grammar School Site at Alton

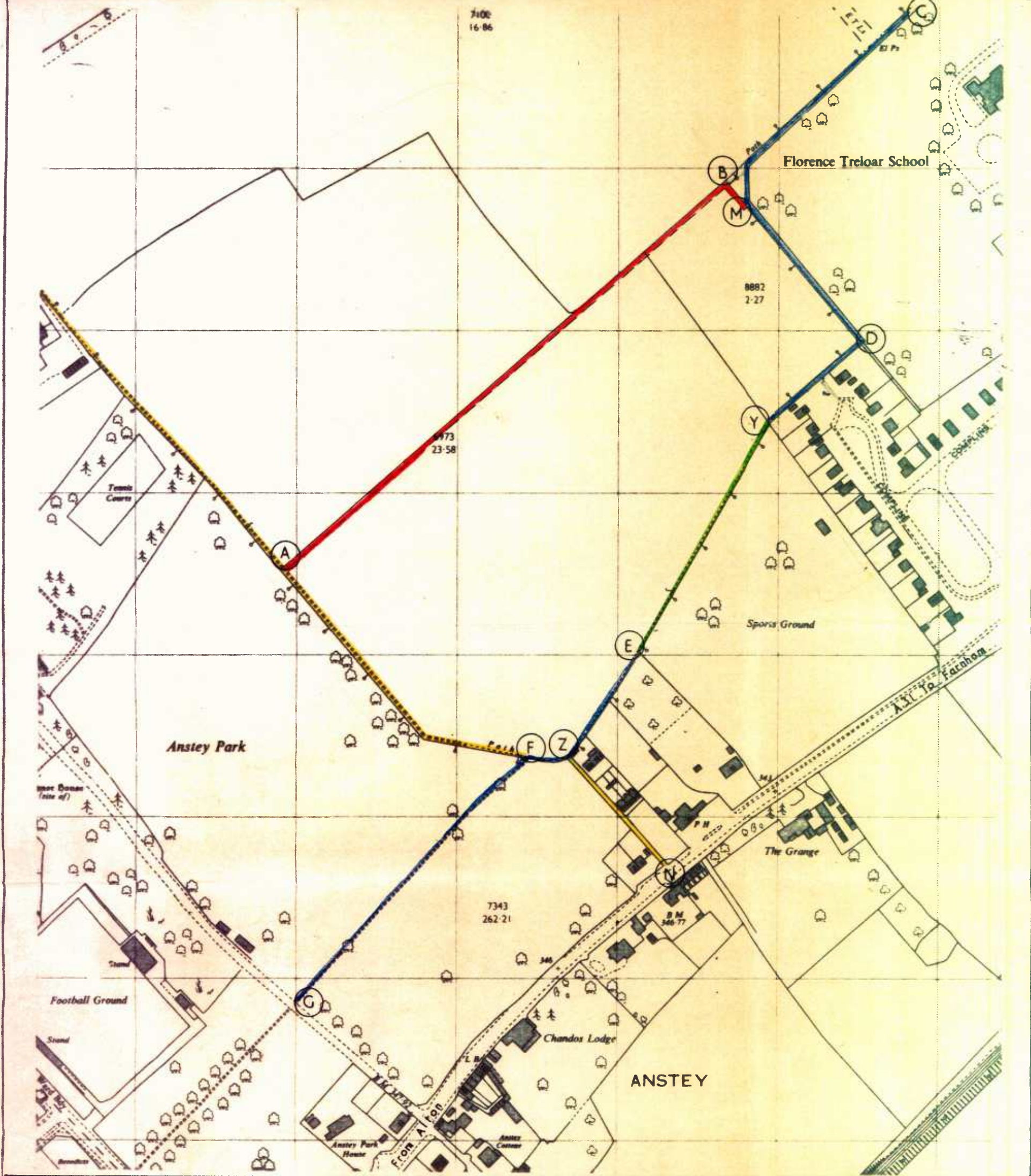
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Minister of Housing and Local Government, in exercise of his powers under Section 3 of the Acquisition of Land (Authorisation Procedure) Act 1946, has made an order extinguishing as from 17th December, 1968, the public right of way over part of Footpath No. 29, Alton, shown coloured green on the map referred to therein which begins at a point marked "E" on the map approximately 90 yards north-east of its junction with Footpath No. 30 adjacent to property No. 16, London-road, and which runs in a north-easterly direction for 180 yards across Eggar's New Grammar School Site to a point marked "Y" on the map at the north-eastern corner of the boundary to No. 12, Complins.

The Order is dated 17th December 1968, and a copy of it and of the map referred to in it showing the right of way extinguished may be inspected at the offices of the Alton Urban District Council' High Street, Alton, Hampshire, during normal office hours.
