- 1.1. That the Executive Member for Environment and Transport gives approval for work on the Transport Strategy and Land Use Vision for Basingstoke as well as associated technical work funded by the Department for Communities and Local Government.
- 1.2. That the Executive Member for Environment and Transport gives approval for collaboration with the Enterprise M3 Local Enterprise Partnership in the development of a submission for Large Local Major Scheme funding in July 2016 for Basingstoke, as detailed in the supporting report.

2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1. The approval is needed to gain agreement to progress transport solutions associated with planned future growth and infrastructure in Basingstoke. The work supports the County Council's vision for economic growth. It will also assist in promoting the main themes set out in the Enterprise M3 Local Enterprise Partnership Strategic Economic Plan, principally those set to improve transport, infrastructure and housing, and enterprise and employment.
