

C&YP SC	<p>The Committee met in May and considered items on Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services, public health in schools and an update on special educational needs and disability reforms implementation. The Committee also met on 1 July to pre scrutinise the proposals regarding a Family Support Service.</p>				
ETE SC	<p>The Committee met in June 2016 and considered an update on Road Casualty Reduction, following pre scrutiny of a change in policy at the March 2016 meeting. As a result the committee resolved to initiate a task & finish group on road safety. The committee also considered a report on School Crossing Patrols, following referral of this topic by the Children & Young People Select Committee (following a request from Cllr Porter). The Committee also received an update on highways maintenance trials, which were initiated following recommendations by the Select Committee. An additional meeting has been convened in July 2016 for the Committee to pre-scrutinise proposals for making savings to the Household Waste Recycling Centres service following a public consultation.</p>				
P&R SC	<p>The committee maintains oversight of the work taking place across the other scrutiny committees. The committee established a sub committee to consider applications for large grants under the community buildings fund, which met in early March 2016 and made recommendations to the Executive Member for Policy & Resources. The committee met in April and considered an update on consultation policy, a presentation on Trading Standards, a presentation from Hampshire Association of Local Councils, and agreed the Annual Report of scrutiny for 2015/16 for submission to Council.</p>				

HASC	<p>The HASC continues to meet six times a year, and has recently considered several temporary closures of services, as well as ongoing substantial changes of service, and is monitoring previous issues. A work programme has been agreed which incorporates issues from health, adult social care and public health. The main focus of the Committee over the coming months are issues related to systems resilience and out of hospital care, as well as contributions to a Joint HOSC on the dorset clinical services review, and strategic clinical services reviews in Hampshire.</p> <p>The Committee met in June and considered items on Andover War Memorial Hospital Minor Injuries Unit – Temporary Change to Operating Hours, Friarsgate Practice – Kings Worthy Branch Surgery Closure, Portsmouth Hospitals NHS Trust: Care Quality Commission Re-Inspection Enforcement Notice – Urgent Care, Southern Health NHS Foundation Trust: Care Quality Commission Re-Inspection Enforcement Notice – Mental Health services, South Central Ambulance Service and South East Coast Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trusts: Ambulance Performance Update.</p>
