## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012 ('the Regulations')**

#### **REGULATION 10 - KEY DECISIONS**

Regulation 10 (general exception) allows for a key decision to be made if it is impracticable for notice of the intention to take a key decision under Regulation 9 to be given 28 clear days in advance of the taking of the decision. Regulation 10 sets out the actions required to be taken in those circumstances which include giving public notice at least five working days before the decision is taken.

The Executive Member for Adult Social Care intends to take a key decision regarding the authority to spend on procurement of Adult Services Transport at a meeting on the 20 July 2016 at 15:00 at: The Castle, Winchester.

It was impracticable to give the required 28 days notice of the Executive Member for Adult Social Care's intention to take this key decision as the need to do so was predicated on the timescales of connected procurement activity elsewhere in the County Council.
