### 1. The decision:

1.1. That approval be given by the Executive Member for Adult Social Care, for the support of voluntary organisations in 2016-17 for the following grant awards:

- i) To award an amount of £100,000 to the partnership led by Good Neighbours Support Service as part of the Adult Services Partnership Grant (as set out in appendix C of the report).
- ii) To award an amount of £90,000 to the partnership led by Carers Together as part of the Adult Services Partnership Grant (as set out in appendix C of the report).
- iii) To award an amount of £100,000 to Hampshire and Isle of Wight Community Foundation towards the Solent Community Grants Programme.

### 2. Reason(s) for the decision:

2.1. To gain approval from the Executive Member for Adult Social Care to enable the Adult Services Department to make grant awards to the organisation detailed within the grants report

2.2. The aim of the Supportive Communities Programme is to reduce, delay and/or divert demand on Adult Services by increasing community self-sufficiency and people's independence. The Adult Services Partnership Grant will be the grant stream to provide funding to infrastructure organisations that can demonstrate their ability to work in partnership with other organisations to support the objectives of the Supportive Communities Programme.

2.3. The Solent Communities Grant Programme has been created to provide grants to support groups who are able to reach and work with individuals with complex barriers to employment, enabling them to move closer or into employment. Approval is sought from the Executive Member for Adult Social

Care to award a grant of £100,000 to Hampshire and Isle Of Wight Community Foundation, who will be managing the fund on behalf of the partnership, in a flow-through fund. If approved, this will be match-funded by the European Structural and Investment Fund grant to ensure that there will be at least £200,000 for the Solent Communities Grant Programme to award to projects in the Hampshire County Council area that falls within the area covered by the Solent Local Enterprise Partnership.
