243. INVESTMENT IN HAMPSHIRE SCHOOLS

1. On the 25 May 2016, the Executive Member for Education gave approval to a number of school expansion projects to increase capacity and to meet demand for school places:

- The permanent expansion of Tweseldown Infant School in Church Crookham, at an estimated total cost of £1,700,000.
- The permanent expansion of King's Furlong Infant School and Nursery and Kings Furlong Junior School in Basingstoke, at an estimated total cost of £4,828,000.
- The permanent expansion of Shakespeare Infant and Junior School in Eastleigh, at an estimated total cost of £3,850,000.
- The permanent expansion of Saint James Church of England Primary School in West End, at an estimated total cost of £4,358,000.

2. The Executive Member approved the construction of a new performing arts studio together with internal refurbishment and recladding of a number of buildings at Swanmore College in Swanmore, at an estimated total cost of £3,350,000. He also gave approval for the construction of a synthetic turf pitch (STP) at Wildern Academy, Hedge End, Southampton at an estimated total cost of £348,000. In both cases, these school improvement works will benefit pupils at the schools and the wider community through the provision of enhanced facilities.
