#### 1. The decision:

1.1 That the Executive Member for Adult Social Care gives approval to spend up to £10 million in order to procure Wellbeing Centres across Hampshire for up to five years, on a three years plus one plus one basis (3 +1 +1). Contracts commencing from 1 September 2017. This approval subject to a further £2 million of funding being secured (as per the report) and total spend not to exceed £8 million if this is not secured.

#### 2. Reason(s) for the decision:

2.1. Wellbeing Centres provide cost effective, preventative services that support individuals with Mental Health problems living in their local communities. They reduce the need for more costly and personally restrictive interventions such as residential care.

#### 3. Other options considered and rejected:

3.1. Consideration was given whether to reduce funding for Wellbeing Centres but due to the adverse impact this would have on service users this option was rejected.
