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1. The decision:

- 1.1. That the Executive Member for Environment and Transport approves the development of a Fly-Tipping Strategy for Hampshire by the County Council, in partnership with a variety of organisations who share the County Council's objective to reduce the impact of fly-tipping in Hampshire, subject to full and final agreement from each relevant organisation.
- 1.2. That the final Fly-Tipping Strategy and associated Action Plan is brought back to the Executive Member for Environment and Transport for adoption at a later date.

2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1. To reduce the harmful impacts of fly-tipping in Hampshire, both in terms of the financial costs to the County Council, other local authorities, and other relevant bodies and landowners, and the environmental and social impacts of the crime.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1. The alternative option that has been considered and rejected is to not develop a Fly-Tipping Strategy for Hampshire.
- 3.2. Such an approach would have been inconsistent with the commitment to develop a Strategy already made in a previous decision taken on 22 July 2016 (ref: 7534: "Household Waste Recycling Centre Service Efficiencies Implementation").
- 3.3. Furthermore it would mean failing to address the issue of fly-tipping in Hampshire, thereby failing to address the ongoing financial costs it creates

for the County Council and other responsible organisations, as well as the other harmful social and environmental impacts.
