1. The decision:

- 1.1. That the Executive Member for Economy, Transport, and Environment approve the Project Appraisal for the proposed Alresford Pedestrian Improvements, Jacklyns Lane, as outlined in the supporting report.
- 1.2. That approval is given to procure, spend and enter into necessary contractual arrangements to implement the proposed Alresford Pedestrian Improvements, Jacklyns Lane, as set out in the supporting report, at an estimated cost of £297,000 to be funded from Developer Contributions and County Council resources.
- 1.3. That authority to make the arrangements to implement the scheme, including minor variations to the design or contract, be delegated to the Director of Economy, Transport, and Environment.

2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. The reason for the decision is to provide improved accessibility and safety for the residents in Alresford in general and Perins school children in particular.
- 2.2. The proposal to deliver environmental improvements in this part of Alresford aligns with the following priorities and objectives set out within Hampshire's Local Transport Plan (2011 – 2031) (LTP):

Management of traffic

Improvement of road safety

Promoting walking and cycling

2.3. This decision supports the Hampshire County Council corporate strategy policy of “making Hampshire safer and more secure for all” and “enhancing our quality of place”.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

3.1. Do nothing. This option has been rejected on the basis that previous minor improvements have not achieved the desired effect. There is a clear case for improving accessibility and ensuring that traffic is managed in a way to allow safer integration of pedestrians to the network, particularly at busy times.

3.2. Funding has been allocated to improve accessibility and enhance the gateway into this part of Alresford.
