1. The following decisions were made:

- a) That the emerging Transport Strategy for Whitehill Bordon Eco Town referred to in paragraph 2.12 be approved as a basis for consultation.
- b) That the recommendations of the background reports on rail pre-feasibility, sub-regional bus strategy and the potential for Park and Ride referred to in paragraph 2.21 be noted, the draft reports be finalised and their contents be considered further in the development of the emerging Transport Strategy for Whitehill Bordon.
- c) That the allocation of Eco Town growth funding for transport projects set out in paragraph 3.5 be approved and that the projects be taken forward for delivery subject to receipt of funding from East Hampshire District Council.
- d) That the schedule of further study work set out in paragraph 3.6 be recommended to East Hampshire District Council and the Whitehill Bordon Executive Group for consideration for funding from the studies budget.

2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. To inform the future development proposals for the Eco Town, to inform policy and strategy approaches and to provide a framework for sustainable development.
- 2.2. To progress delivery of the Early Wins transport projects.
- 2.3. To secure additional necessary study work funding.

3.1. Not to produce a transport strategy. This was rejected as the production of an overarching Transport Strategy will be critical in delivering sustainable growth as part of the Eco Town proposals.
