**1. Purpose of Report**

- 1.1 For the Health and Adult Social Care Select Committee to pre-scrutinise the proposal to bring in house and to directly provide respite care currently provided by Southern Health Foundation Trust at Jacobs Lodge. Jacobs Lodge is a 6 bed respite unit in Totton for people with severe learning disabilities.
- 1.2 Jacobs Lodge is a property owned by Hampshire County Council and currently care services are provided by Southern Health Foundation Trust (SHFT). This approval is sought because SHFT have decided to withdraw from the provision of respite at Jacobs Lodge.
- 1.3 This report explains the requirement for the continuation of this service and the reason for the recommended option.
