Building	Rationale for decision
<b>Basingstoke</b>	
Lily pads, Chineham Library	Low level of deprivation and accommodation is unsuitable for future use as available space is limited.
The Courtyard, Lychpit Community Centre	Low level of deprivation and accommodation is unsuitable for future use as space is limited.
Pebbles, Popley	Whilst level of deprivation is higher than proposed building to be retained, available space is limited due to shared occupation. The wider site has been identified for some time for potential alternative use.
Octopus, Oakridge Hall for All	Lower level of deprivation and accommodation is unsuitable for future use as space is limited.
Badgers, Bishops Green Community Centre	Lower level of deprivation and accommodation is unsuitable for future use as space is limited.
Home Tree, Tadley Community Centre	Low level of deprivation and accommodation is unsuitable for future use as space is limited.
Honeycomb, Chiltern Way	In one of the most deprived areas within Basingstoke (building in highest area of deprivation represents greater opportunity for alternative use) and meets accommodation requirements for the proposed FSS service. This has the greatest footfall of the Basingstoke Children's Centres, based on current service delivery (medium usage*).
Westside, Westside Community Centre, South Ham	Lower level of deprivation and accommodation is unsuitable for future use as space is limited.
Buttercups, Manor Field Infant School, Brighton Hill	Lower level of deprivation than building proposed for retention and accommodation is unsuitable for future use as space is limited.
Snowdrops, Overton Community Centre	Low level of deprivation and accommodation is unsuitable for future use as space is very limited.

<b>East Hants</b>	
Bushy Leaze, Alton	Located in an area of deprivation within East Hants and meets accommodation requirements for the proposed future service.
Heath, Petersfield	Low level of deprivation and accommodation is unsuitable for future use as space is limited.
Chase, Bordon	Lower level of deprivation than Bushy Leaze.
<b>Eastleigh</b>	
Windmill, Bursledon	Low level of deprivation and less space available than building proposed for retention.
Little Coppice, Fair Oak	Low level of deprivation and less space available than building proposed for retention.
West End Gateway, West End Community Centre	Lower level of deprivation and very limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
Hop-a-Long, Botley	Low level of deprivation and limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
The Nest, Hedge End	Lower level of deprivation and limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
Chamberlayne, Chamberlayne Road, Eastleigh	Whilst level of deprivation is higher than proposed building to be retained, there is less space available and no parking making it less suitable for future use.
Aviary, Blackbird Road, Eastleigh	Located in an area of deprivation within Eastleigh and meets the accommodation requirements for the proposed FSS service. It has high footfall*.
Caterpillar Hill, Chandlers Ford	Low level of deprivation and limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
<b>Fareham</b>	
Oak Meadow, Tewkesbury Avenue, Fareham	Located in an area of high deprivation and meets the accommodation requirements for the proposed future service. It has the highest footfall in the Fareham district*.
Keepsake, Portchester	Lower level of deprivation and limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
Sovereign, Sarisbury Green	Lower level of deprivation and limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
Merryfields, St Annes Grove, Fareham	Lower level of deprivation than building proposed for retention.
<b>Gosport</b>	
Haven, Bridgemary	Lower level of deprivation and very limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
Rowner Sure Start Centre	Located in an area of high deprivation and meets the accommodation requirements for the proposed new service. It has a high level of footfall*.
Stubblee Hill, Lee-on-	Lower level of deprivation and less space available than building proposed for retention.

Little Waves, St Vincent College Campus, Gosport	Lower level of deprivation than area of building proposed for retention. Additionally notice has been given by landowner that the site is to be re-developed.
Tree House, Elson	Lower level of deprivation than building proposed for retention.
Haselbridge, Stone Lane, Gosport	Lower level of deprivation and limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
<b>Hart</b>	
Woodlark, Yateley	Low level of deprivation and limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
Water Lilies, Frogmore	Low level of deprivation and limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
Wisteria, Odiham	Low level of deprivation and limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
Little Saplings, Hartley Witney	Low level of deprivation and limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
Turners Wood, Elvetham Heath	This meets the accommodation requirements for the proposed future service. It has the highest footfall in the Hart district*.
Fireflies, Fleet	Low level of deprivation and limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
Wild Rose	Low level of deprivation and limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
<b>Havant</b>	
Park Futures, Sandleford Road, Havant	Lower level of deprivation in location of building compared to the building proposed for retention. Additionally building is within control of CSD.
Sharps Copse, Prospect Lane, Havant	Located in an area of high deprivation and meets the accommodation requirements for the proposed new service. It has the highest footfall in the Havant district*.
Starfish, Hayling Island	Lower level of deprivation than other buildings in Havant.
The Orchard, Emsworth	Lower level of deprivation than other buildings in Havant.
Trospacc, Stockheath Lane, Havant	Lower level of deprivation and space available less suitable than building proposed for retention.
Branches, Horndean	Lower level of deprivation and limited space available making it unsuitable for future use.
Links, Wecock Farm	Lower level of deprivation in location of building compared to the building proposed for retention.
Crookhorn Lane, Crookhorn	Lower level of deprivation in location of building compared to the building proposed for retention.
<b>New Forest</b>	
Forest First, Blackfield	Whilst level of deprivation is higher than proposed building to be retained, the building does not belong to HCC and cost of maintaining, would be significantly higher.
Cadland, Fawley	Located in an area of high deprivation and meets the accommodation requirements for the proposed new

	service. It has a high level of footfall*.
Waterside, Dibden Purlieu	Accommodation less suitable for future use than building proposed for retention.
The Patch, Calmore	Accommodation unsuitable for future use.
Harbour, Eling	Accommodation unsuitable for future use.
Phoenix, New Milton	Accommodation less suitable for future use than building proposed for retention. Additionally the building will no longer be available as a children's centre due to it's conversion in to a Free School.
All Seasons, Pennington	Lower level of deprivation and space available less suitable than building proposed for retention.
Pathways, Ringwood	Lower level of deprivation and space available less suitable than building proposed for retention.
Bridges, Fordingbridge	Lower level of deprivation and space available less suitable than building proposed for retention.
<b>Rushmoor</b>	
Park, Gloucester Road, Aldershot	Located in an area of high deprivation and meets the accommodation requirements for the proposed new service. It has a high level of footfall*.
Owls, Mayfield Road, Farnborough	Lower level of deprivation in location of building compared to the building proposed for retention.
Maple Vue, Belle Vue Road, Aldershot	Lower level of deprivation in location of building compared to the building proposed for retention.
Butterflies, Fernhill Road, Farnborough	Lower level of deprivation in location of building compared to the building proposed for retention.
Sycamore, Cunnington Road, Farnborough	Lower level of deprivation in location of building compared to the building proposed for retention and accommodation unsuitable for future use.
<b>Test Valley</b>	
Spring Meadow, Smannell Road, Andover	Located in an area of high deprivation and meets the accommodation requirements for the proposed new service. It has the highest level of footfall in the Test Valley district*.
Acorns, Vigo Road, Andover	Accommodation very limited and unsuitable for future use.
Little Oaks, Romsey	Lower level of deprivation in location of building compared to the building proposed for retention and accommodation less suitable for future use.
Poppies, Barton Stacey	Lower level of deprivation in location of building compared to the building proposed for retention and accommodation less suitable for future use.
Water Meadow, Stockbridge	Lower level of deprivation in location of building compared to the building proposed for retention.
<b>Winchester</b>	
Merry go Round Children's	Located in an area of higher deprivation within Winchester district and meets the accommodation

Centre, Wickham	requirements for the proposed new service. It has the highest level of footfall in Winchester district*
Sparklers Children's Centre Winnall, Winchester	This building is the most deprived area in Winchester district. However, the building is exceptionally small and unsuitable in relation to requirements for future use with space to accommodate only 2/3 staff and a small meeting room suitable only for 1-1 or two families. It is located at a community centre which can continue to be used as a delivery site. Level of footfall is low.
Lanterns Nursery School and Children's Centre	Low level of deprivation and insufficient space for staff accommodation. As this is a nursery school, additional costs may apply.
The Carroll Children's Centre, Stanmore, Winchester	This is not a HCC controlled building and therefore HCC would have to pay rent as well as other service charges. Limited accommodation available for staff and level of deprivation in location lower than Merry go round and Sparklers. Level of footfall is low.
Reign and Shine Children's Centre, Kingsworthy	Low level of deprivation and low level of footfall.
Sunbeams Children's Centre, Alresford	Low level of deprivation and medium level of footfall although still lower than Merry go Round.
Little Petals Children's Centre, Bishops Waltham	Low level of deprivation and low level of footfall.
Happy Valley Children's Centre, Denmead	Level of footfall is low and deprivation level in location is medium but lower than Merry-go-round
