Details of the Bid / Project

We are hoping to build a Youth facility within the grounds of the Lloyd Recreation Ground. The new build will have a very positive impact on the community as it will be a focal point and meeting place for all the youngsters of the village. For instance, the Youth Group, Scouts, Guides etc will have a permanent base to operate from giving them a place to meet, socialise and seek advice as well as providing a venue for local Community groups to use during the day.

The local Youth Group at present have no meeting area and the youth worker has to do detached youth work namely `street meets`.

They had used the local snooker hall on a Wednesday night for the past three years, but the local users objected that the 'temporary' club had become 'too permanent' so they were asked to leave.

The present Scout Hut is in a very bad state of repair. The Guides hire the school hall but, each time the school has an event, their guide meeting is cancelled.

At present we have secured funds of £150,000 from section 106 monies and seeking £85,000 for New Forest District Councils' youth grant scheme.

We have a design of the building and, as of yet, not gone out to tender. We have asked a local builder for a rough estimate and they have come back with a quote in the region of £250,000 .
