#### **1. The decision:**

- 1.1. That a storage certificate be granted, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the Petroleum (Consolidation) Regulations 2014, in respect of premises at Manor Farm Estate, West Tisted, Alresford, SO24 0HL.
- 1.2. That the said storage certificate be for the purpose of storage of petrol, as defined within the Petroleum (Consolidation) Regulations 2014.
- 1.3. That the said storage certificate be valid indefinitely.

#### **2. Reason(s) for the decision:**

- 2.1. Hampshire County Council is a petroleum enforcement authority for the purpose of the Petroleum (Consolidation) Regulations 2014.
- 2.2. Regulation 4 of the Petroleum (Consolidation) Regulations 2014 prohibits any person from keeping petrol except in accordance with the legislation; which includes the requirement for a storage certificate to be granted by the relevant petroleum enforcement authority.
