The swimmers selected will demonstrate the potential to swim competitively at the highest level but who currently swim immediately below the level of elite swimmers catered for within the Beacon Programme. This provision is necessary to prepare swimmers for the intensive demands of the World Class Programmes they should move into in the future. The grant will be used to offer swimmers training camps, specialised swim clinics, ongoing physiotherapy and nutritional support and mentoring opportunities for club coaches on how to coach elite swimmers.
