CHILDREN, YOUNG PEOPLE AND FAMILIES

AIM

Children, young people and families have choice and opportunities to access our services to support their wellbeing

Outcome

Grow the offer to all **children, young people & families** through supporting curriculum learning, social and recreational activities in order to increase cultural participation and personal development

Outcome

To work with identified groups to support their general school attainment and address the health and participation inequalities of CYP & F; and to improve the opportunities for **children in care, disabled children** and **socially disadvantaged groups** to participate in cultural, leisure and personal development activities

Measure

Participation: increased levels of participation by under-represented groups (Mosaic group B)
Satisfaction with CCRA services of children, young people and families is improved
Community profiling
School visits to museums

Measure

Participation: children in care, disabled children and socially disadvantaged groups have improved opportunities to take part
