1. The decision:

- 1.1. That the Executive Member for Economy, Transport and Environment confirms the revised extent of the land required to form the southern section of the proposed Newgate Lane South road scheme (“the Scheme”), in accordance with the approved alignment;
- 1.2. That the Executive Member for Economy, Transport and Environment recommends that the Executive Member for Policy and Resources provides authority to acquire all third party interests in the land required for the delivery of the Scheme, as detailed in the appendix;
- 1.3. That the Executive Member for Economy, Transport, and Environment recommends to the Executive Member for Policy and Resources that a Compulsory Purchase Order be made for the Scheme.

2. Reason for the decision:

- 2.1. The decision is required to make a minor adjustment to the extent of land agreed to form part of the potential Compulsory Purchase Order at the Executive Member for Economy, Transport and Environment Decision Day on the 26th November 2015, and thereafter at the Executive Member for Policy and Resources Decision Day held on the 10th December, 2015. This minor adjustment is necessary to minimise risk to the delivery timetable and implementation of the Scheme.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

- 3.1 An alternative option would be to leave the extent of land authorised for potential CPO as agreed at the Executive Member for Policy and Resources

Decision Day in December 2015. This option was rejected on the grounds that a minor but important addition is required to safeguard the delivery of the Scheme, reflecting the currently ambiguous status of the land to be added.
