

**MATTERS ARISING FROM NEW FOREST HAT HIGHWAYS MEETING
HELD ON 2 November 2010**

1) Cllr Rice requested footway lighting on the A337 to be added to the street lighting PFI schedule of works (page 1)

Response/update: Julian Higgins has advised that both HCC and NFDC policies preclude provision of lighting in the New Forest Heritage Area, unless there is a demonstrable personal security issue which can't be addressed by other means.

2) Longstock Crescent, Totton was listed as completed as part of the 2010/11 special maintenance programme, Cllr Weeks indicated that this has not been completed. (page 2)

Response/update: Richard to meet with Cllr Weeks – ideally before the HAT meeting in April to review this and other highway issues in Totton area.

3) Vehicle parking at Ibsley Garage, vehicles cannot pass the lorries and the police need to be involved (page 2).

Response/update: Paul Garrod contacted Dave Taylor from Hampshire Police Traffic Management Unit about Ibsley Garage on 15/11/10 and was advised that the Police have been out on several occasions but not found any problems.

4) Cllr Mans asked to be advised on the costs of the speed reductions on Southampton Road, Lyndhurst (page 3).

Response/update: Paul Garrod emailed Cllr Mans on the 18/11/10 to advise that the costs of the scheme was approximately £1,400.

5) Members suggested reviewing other local authorities that have national parks what traffic calming measures they use.

Response/update: There is a paper on this under strategic and local issues prepared by Paul Garrod.

5) With regard to the Minor Works under £50,000, Richard Bastow to review the 6 schemes presented and further consult with Members to determine the programme for 2011/12 by the end of December 2010 (page 5).

Response/update: Schemes are currently still under review and comments made at the meeting in November are being considered.

6) Richard to meet with Nick Hunt from NFDC to review any developers contributions towards the schemes presented to the Members (page 5).

Response/update: Meeting held with NFDC – limited scope in National Park Area.
