#### 1. Apologies

Apologies were received from Councillors Edgar, Evans, Price and Woodward and David Duckett.

#### 2. Previous Actions

The action taken on previous highways and traffic management issues was noted.

Councillor Knight asked about the footbridge over the River Meon at Titchfield Haven and suggested that developer contributions relating to the development at Daedalus could be used to fund it. Chris Lait to contact Planning Officers.

Councillor Carter reported that a central island was required at the junction of Privett Road and House Farm Road, Gosport. Chris Lait to bring this to the attention of ITS.

Councillor Carter asked that the request for crossing facilities at Twyford Drive, Lee-on-the-Solent outside Lee Community Centre be re-investigated. Chris Lait to investigate this request again.

**3. Progress with 2009/10 schemes**

The current status of the Maintenance and Special Maintenance Schemes, Capital Programme Schemes, Traffic Management Programme and Traffic Regulation Orders (TROs) was noted.

It was noted that Gosport TROs were not a higher priority than Fareham ones, but a large amount of external funding had recently been received for the Gosport ones.

**4. Priorities for Capital Programme 2010/11**

Chris Lait presented slides showing the Fareham Minor Works schemes and asked Members to agree the priority schemes bearing in mind that there was approximately £25,000 in the budget.

Members discussed the merits of all of the Fareham schemes and agreed that the following schemes would be added to the work programme and be progressed when funding was available, in order of priority (highest first):-

- (i) New footway at Posbrook Lane;
- (ii) Pedestrian refuge at Stubbington Green;
- (iii) New footway at Sweethills Crescent;
- (iv) Pedestrian refuge at Stubbington Lane, Stubbington; and
- (v) New footway at Avenue Road.

It was noted that the Gosport Minor Works list would be circulated to Members following the meeting and selection and approval of the schemes would then be dealt with at the Local Highways Meeting in March 2010.

The current status of the feasibility studies was noted.

The Traffic Regulation Programme for Gosport was noted. The list of schemes had been circulated to Members prior to the meeting to allow prioritisation to take place.

**5. List of Topics for Carrying Forward**

Members were updated on the following Local Issues:-

Quay Street Roundabout

It was noted that this scheme was due to start in April/May 2010.

Daedalus

A draft Transport Assessment had been received from SEEDA and was currently being evaluated.

Cherque Way/Portsmouth Road

The Traffic Regulation Orders were currently being processed.

Hunts Pond Road

Work had commenced in November and was due to last for fourteen weeks.

Segensworth Business Forum

The Framework Travel Plan had been completed and an Access Plan was currently being formulated.

Update on Quality of Place Schemes

Schemes were being drawn up for both Fareham and Gosport.

Rowner Improvements Scheme

Members were updated on the following Strategic Issues:-

Transport for South Hampshire

BRT

Wider Transport Studies

Work was currently being carried out on a Delivering a Sustainable Transport System study, a study of the M27 Corridor, Junctions 5 -12 concerning the effects of proposed developments and an Access to Gosport Study.

Wider BRT Study

Access to Queen Alexandra Hospital

Improvements had been made to the bus routes serving the Hospital.

North Whiteley

LAA Congestion Targets

Two areas were being targeted – A32 Corridor on the Gosport peninsula and M27 Junction 9 - and studies were being prepared.

**6. Any Other Business**

Manhole - North Hill, Fareham

Councillor Hockley reported that there was a manhole in North Hill, Fareham with water spilling from it. Chris Lait to pass on the information to the relevant Officers for action.
