**Matters Arising
Actions from Previous Local Highways Meeting
30th November 2009**

Privett Road / House Farm Road, Gosport: - Councillor Carter's request for an island to be incorporated within the existing crossing point has been passed to ITS for investigation. The site is programmed for upgrade to a puffin crossing but there are some difficulties with installing an island, such as available road width and the need for additional signal heads on the island. However this will be investigated by ITS.

Twyford Drive Pedestrian Crossing Request: - There are difficulties associated with locating an island at this location. Visibility is very good here so it would be difficult to improve although site checks will be carried out to ensure nothing further can be done. Bollards have been requested at the existing dropped kerbs to highlight the crossing point but the provision of bollards would restrict pavement widths too much. Coloured surfacing has not got local support. Therefore no further action can be taken on this item.

Residents suggest that this has increased since the waiting restrictions have been implemented on Cherque Way – initial observations do not substantiate this but further parking surveys will be undertaken.
