1. **Bus access from Fareham to Queen Alexandra Hospital, Portsmouth** – Verbal update will be given in Item 6.
2. **Item 07/09 Old Turnpike/Wickham Road on the Issues Log** – priority has been changed to Medium and an update is included in Item 3.
3. **Quality of new materials** – A 7% failure rate has been reported which is primarily due to the inclement weather experienced towards the end of the programme.
4. **Hunts Pond Road Safety audit** – this has now been carried out and the relevant Members have been informed of the outcome.
5. **Southampton Hill refuge island** - Councillor Hockley was contacted and the delays that had occurred with this scheme were explained.
6. **The list of salt bin requests to be discussed with Fareham Borough Council** - Fareham Borough Council have now approved the list via its Chief Executive.
7. **Possible external funding for a footway on Cranleigh Road/Cornaway Lane** – Investigations have shown that there is no external funding available for this work.
8. **The Segensworth Action Plan is to be taken to the HAT in Autumn 2010** – A verbal update on this is included in Item 6. A copy of the Implementation Plan is appended to Item 6 and copies of the full Action Plan are available on request.
9. **Yew Tree Drive, Whiteley consultation** – Consultation has concluded and Members have been advised.
10. **Portchester Homezone railway sleepers appear to be rotting** – Deterioration has been noted and funding will be prioritised as appropriate. The local Member has been updated.
