MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MEETING AND PREVIOUS ACTIONS

The attached table details matters raised at the Autumn Highways HAT meeting.

**Matters Arising
Actions from Previous Local Highways Meeting
6th October 2010**

- Action 1: 2010/11 Special Maintenance scheme - Church Lane Botley:** Officers reported that the scheme had been deferred. The Parish Council reported that the condition is deteriorating due to drainage issue and water seeping into patches, freezing and then patches coming out. The lane is used by heavy agricultural vehicles and also has a high number of pedestrians. **Action:** Officers to revisit.
- Update:** An order has been raised for planned structural patching.
- Action 2: 2010/11 Special Maintenance scheme - Broad Oak, High Street and Mill Hill, Botley:** Botley Clock Tower – the Parish reported that they perceive that heavy traffic volume is causing the market hall to subside and for the clock to keep becoming unbalanced. **Action:** Officers to note.
- Update:** Noted by officers.
- Action 3: 2010/11 Capital Programme - Hursley Road puffin crossing:** **Action:** Officers to advise local Member of start date.
- Update:** Local Member was updated prior to the scheme going forward in November for Executive Member approval. The scheme is currently on site.
- Action 4: 2010/11 Capital Programme - Variable Messaging system-Eastleigh Town Centre car parks:** There are delays in the procurement impacting on the project. **Action:** Chris Lait to make enquiries regarding the delays. Local Member to be kept informed.
- Update:** Local Member has been kept informed on progress with this project. Contract is to be awarded at the end of March 2011.
- Action 5: 2010/11 HCC Traffic Management Programme - A & B Road Speed Limit Review:** Members noted the table and were reassured that the recommendations of the A & B road reviews will be discussed with Members. **Action:** A & B road review to be an agenda item in the March 2011 HAT Highways meeting.
- Update:** Update included in Item 6.
- Action 6: Eastleigh Borough Council Traffic Management Programme Update 2010/11:** **Action:** Stuart Robinson-Woledge to update table 3c for HAT officer to circulate.
- Update:** Eastleigh officers updated this table and it was circulated to Members.

- Action 7: 2011/12 Minor Works Programme - Charterhouse Way and Winchester Street:** Members agreed to prioritise the following works for inclusion in the 2010/11 programme:
- Charterhouse Way. Hedge End, West End and Botley (HEWEB) Local Area Committee agreed to meet the shortfall in funding.
 - Winchester Street, Boorley Green – scheme is now fully funded
- Action:** Charterhouse Way and Winchester Street schemes to be moved into the 2010/11 programme now funding is secure.
- Update:** Schemes were moved into the 2010/11 programme. However, Charterhouse Way scheme was put on hold until land acquisition issues can be resolved and Winchester Street was deferred to the 2011/12 programme due to resource issues.
- Action 8: 2011/12 Minor Works Programme - Templars Way.** Members agreed a new footway link on Templars Way, adjacent Lulworth close, as a priority for the 2011/12 programme. **Action:** Richard Bastow to liaise with Test Valley Borough Council and Local Member re Templars Way.
- Update:** The scheme will be implemented in early 2011/12.
- Action 9: 2011/12 Minor Works Programme - Woodside Avenue.** **Action:** Woodside Avenue - lamp post to be moved as part of Private Finance Initiative for street lighting - can be removed from this list.
- Update:** Noted and removed from list.
- Action 10: 2011/12 Minor Works Programme.** **Action:** The priorities for 2011/12 be submitted for inclusion in the minor works capital programme to the Executive Member of Environment
- Update:** The budget for the 2011/12 programme has been set at £35,000 enabling identified priorities to be taken forward.
- Action 11: 2011/12 Capital Programme - Hedge End / Botley cycles.** This was previously 2 schemes but have now been merged. Several design details need to be resolved to progress the scheme to implementation. **Action:** Officers to keep local Member informed as the Hedge End/ Botley Cycles detailed design progresses.
- Update:** Local Members have been kept informed.
- Action 12: 2011/12 Capital Programme - Crestwood School:** Land issues need resolving. **Action:** Officers to update local Member on land issues.
- Update:** Local Member was updated on this scheme and the land issues and advised of the scheme start date. Scheme implementation has now begun.

Action 13: HCC Traffic Management sub-programme - Safety Issues at Hiltingbury Road. Local Members advised officers that there was a road traffic accident involving a cyclist the previous week. **Action:** Officers to investigate safety issue in Hiltingbury Road as a high priority.

Update: Officers will investigate these as a high priority in the 2011/12 Traffic Management programme.

Action 14: Archers Road Footbridge. The local Member reported that bits are falling off the bridge. Officers advised Members that there is no funding available to replace the bridge. **Action:** Officers to request a report on the current condition of Archers footbridge.

Update: The last completed inspection was undertaken in May 2009. A further inspection is due in 2011, with the exact date depending on railway possessions. No repairs have been undertaken since the May 2009 inspection, but the severe winter weather has caused spalling of the risers of the concrete steps and repairs are being arranged. It is anticipated that this work will be undertaken by end of March.

Action 15: Transport Contribution Policy Scheme List. Action: Officers to re-look at the table and incorporate views of Members.

Update: Members views have been incorporated into the list.

Action 16: Co-ordination of road works. It was agreed that communication should be improved between the County/ Borough, bus companies and taxi traders so that others know what work is going on, why and the start and end dates of the works. **Action:** Officers to ensure that details are in the monthly HAT bulletins and these bulletins are sent to the taxi trade.

Update: These groups are now sent the monthly HAT bulletins. The representative from the Taxi Forum (Alan Lloyd) has also been advised of the link to the ELGIN website as a source of more up to date information.

Action 17: Parish Council pilot to “sign off” small utilities works: Botley Parish Council and the Association of Parish and Town Councils proposed that there be a number of small pilots whereby Parishes could check on the quality of small utility repairs to assist the County using digital photos etc. Botley Parish Council are willing to volunteer as a pilot area. **Action:** Officers to consider and look into suggestion regarding Parish Council pilot to sign-off small utilities works.

Update: This has not progressed due to other work pressures. However, HCC would welcome feedback from Parishes to enable inspections to be targeted more efficiently.
