ACTIONS ARISING FROM HAT MEETING HELD ON 27 APRIL 2010

1) Following the presentation on Winter Maintenance, a number of issues were raised by Members to be taken into consideration in the review of Winter Maintenance policy. Colin Taylor passed these to the Winter Maintenance Policy Review Group.

A map showing the location of existing grit bins has been sent out to Members. A list of proposed locations was sent on 15 September.

2) Southgate Street, Winchester. Other areas of footway resurfacing have been considered and there are three schemes in this year's programme.

3) Cllr Hindson asked about progress with the under £25,000 scheme, Black Horse Lane. This information was provided.

4) Capital Improvement schemes - query on St Cross Bridge cycle path for Dominic McGrath. This was answered by Dominic on 1 June. The contractors had spilt grass seed on the new surface – this had subsequently been treated.

5) Beeches Hill - query on start date. This scheme has now been completed.

6) Cllr Mason queried the extent of work planned for Hensting Lane. This information was provided - proposed extent of works is up to the riding school.

7) Query for Dominic McGrath on developer funding for 2010/11 Capital Improvement Schemes - answered by e-mail on 1 June. Funding from four developments, refs 06/03710/FUL, 06/03645/FUL, W00845/13 and W06440/05.

8) Query for Dominic on bus stops answered by e-mail on 1 June. Locations were: Stoney Lane - opposite the junction with St Matthews Road and Romsey Road - opposite the junction with Sleepers Hill.

9) Drainage schemes - Members asked for a copy of the latest rolling programme for Winchester drainage schemes. This was sent out on 19 May 2010.
