**Matters Arising  
Actions from Previous Local Highways Meetings  
23<sup>rd</sup> April 2010**

**Park House Farm Way/Middle Park Way surface dressing** – highways officers to advise local Member of anticipated start date for remedial works.

**Table 2** – all outstanding actions have been incorporated into the Havant Traffic and Transport Issues Log.

**Park Lane Bridleway 123** – all outstanding snagging issues have now been funded and works will be implemented this financial year.

**Park House Farm Way** – item is included in the 2010/11 Traffic Management Programme.

**Verge Parking** – a priority list was established at previous task force meetings so it is not proposed to have a further meeting .

**Amey** – update to be provided by Amey in item 7.

**Minor Works Programme** – Members requested that Beach Road, Hayling Island, and Brockenhurst Avenue, Warren Park be added to the Minor Works programme for prioritisation. These schemes have been added to the 2010/11 capital programme.

**Review of Winter Maintenance** – points raised by the Members were considered as part of the review.

**West of Waterlooville MDA** – Members requested a detailed written report on the progress of this development. A copy of the report taken to the HAT on 17<sup>th</sup> June 2010 providing an update and integration briefing on the West of Waterlooville Major Development Area is attached.

**Cycling Route at Warblington** – a written report was requested on the plans to create a cycle path using land being donated by Warblington School and Network Rail. An update on this project is included in agenda item 7.
