

**Matters Arising from Highways HAT meeting held on 9 April 2010**

(1) Page 4: It was noted that Longstock Crescent : Totton was not listed on table 1 and Moyles Court: Ellingham had slipped to 2010/11 programme.

**Action: Kevin Fuller to investigate and report back**

**Response:** Both Longstock Crescent, Totton and Moyles Court, Ellingham have been completed as part of the 2010/11 Special Maintenance Programme

(2) Page 4: Councillors reported that as a result of the Roman Road South: Dibden Purlieu scheme, a number of trees had been cut down which had resulted in a number of complaints about an increase in noise.

**Action: Kevin Fuller to investigate and report back**

**Response:** A number of trees were felled by Southern Gas

(3) Page 4: A request was made for waiting restrictions on Salisbury Road: Fordingbridge to be reviewed again. The Police are issuing tickets as they consider it to be dangerous.

**Action: Nick Hunt to investigate and report back**

**Response:** The following reserve scheme was added to the programme, a meeting with members has taken place and more detailed proposals are to be prepared in Autumn 2010.

(4) Page 5 Councillors were asked to highlight any particular top priorities from the list in table 6. It was agreed that Ruth Olczyk would consult with Councillors individually to prioritise the programme.

(5) Page 5 There was a request for another reserve scheme: vehicle parking at Ibsley.

**Action: Nick Hunt to review and report back**

**Response:** Ibsley Garage - Lorry Traffic & Parking (MW) Not breaching planning conditions (CJR checked). Felt that restrictions would just displace vehicles further along road. Beat Officer and RPU have not found obstruction, just parking.

(6) Page 6 Councillors asked whether the Programme could be revised and queried Longstock Crescent, Totton and Broomy Plain Road, Fordingbridge.
