**Matters Arising
from Highways HAT Meeting held on
22 October 2010**

- Action 1:** **Officers to keep HAT Members updated on meeting regarding enforcement of Traffic Orders with Police and Gosport Borough Council** – Meeting held between Hampshire County Council, Police and Gosport Borough Council. Update provided to Members through the HAT coordinator.
- Action 2:** **Brockhurst roundabout sight lines** – All foliage has now been removed and any sight line issues resolved.
- Action 3:** **Halliday Close** – Units will just have new lanterns, similar to existing, installed as the existing street lighting columns are in good condition.
- Action 4:** **Low-level lights around Albert/Victoria Road/Russell and Camden Street** – Lights are not on the adopted highway therefore do not form part of the PFI contract.
- Action 5:** **Bus Rapid Transport (BRT) Communications strategy** – Update provided in Item 7.
