**Hampshire Action Team (HAT) meeting - Winchester - 5 April 2011**

**Notes on actions from last meeting (7 October 2010)**

1.0 Grit bins for schools

*Grit bins have to be installed on highway land for maintenance and access by a lorry for filling. Many of the locations for the new bins will be near schools.*

1.1 Maps of grit bins

*County wide maps showing locations of bins are being produced and will be available as a layer on the GIS system.*

1.2 Vegetation at Otterbourne Road

*As requested, weeds have been cleared by the cycleway in Otterbourne Road.*

1.3 Berewecke Road drainage

*This work has had to be reprogrammed and the start date for these works is mid April 2011.*

2.0 Hensting Lane

*The extent of works in Hensting Lane has been amended, but pre-start information on the finally agreed work was sent out to Members on 1 February 2011.*

2.1 Drainage scheme programmes

*In future, all planned maintenance works including drainage schemes, will be centrally co-ordinated. Programmes will be produced for HAT meetings in the same way as resurfacing schemes are dealt with currently.*

3.0 Response to Winchester Action on Climate Change

6.0 Resurfacing areas

*Cllr Bailey enquired about the extent of work for Sarum Road. This information is confirmed as Woodman Lane to Kilham Lane.*

7.0 Hambledon

*Cllr Coates enquired about condition of footways in Hambledon and mentioned the cost/benefit situation for the proposed flood alleviation scheme. The footways have been inspected and reactive repairs done as required.*

8.0 Traffic management programme

*Councillors contacted about individual schemes. Lists delayed with reconsideration of assessment processes.*

9.0 Waiting restrictions

10.0 National Cycle Route

*Update provided to Members by e-mail. The proposed route links the city centre (end of Stage 1) through to the Bushfield roundabout via Domun Road, over Garnier Road then alongside the Hockley Link utilising the Viaduct. Feasibility work is currently underway.*

11.0 Special maintenance - Teg Down Meads

*This road has now been included in the Resilience resurfacing programme for Quarter 2 in 2011/12.*

12.0 Restoration resurfacing scheme - Otterbourne Road

*The concerns of the Parish Council were considered and a response sent to the Parish Council.*

13.0 Gulley cleansing

*The colour of the spot used for 2010/11 was confirmed to Cllr Porter as green.*

14.0 Jetting programme

*In the event, the jetting work had to be carried out in a more piecemeal fashion due to severe weather conditions and other problems.*

15.0 Gritting of footways

*There was concern that residents were deterred from clearing the footways outside their houses due to fear of liability should a passer-by slip and be injured. DfT have issued guidance to the effect that prosecution would be very unlikely.*

16.0 Grit bin locations

*Lists of locations had been issued to Members as they had been finalised.*
