

**MATTERS ARISING FROM TEST VALLEY HAT HIGHWAYS MEETING
HELD ON 29th October 2010**

1) Maintenance and special maintenance schemes update- no reference to Thruxton Road/Thruxton Green in the programme and this should be (page 2).

Response/update: Works to repair damage to the Thruxton stream wall are complete

2) School Lane Roundabout needs to be assessed as it is prone to flooding and needs a soak away (page 2).

Response/update: The site has been inspected by the Local highways Engineer and orders placed to clear vegetation and clean out the ditches. This should be sufficient to reduce the flooding but the LHE will continue to monitor the situation and will instruct further works if necessary.

3) Cllr Drew asked if Heron's rise could be added to the Maintenance Programme (page 3)

Response/update: Heron Rise has been inspected. It is intended to patch the carriageway during next financial years for inclusion in a future surface dressing programme. The footways will be considered for refurbishment once works associated with water metering boxes and the street lighting PFI are complete.

4) North Baddersley Accessibility Scheme to be added to the over £50k programme (page 3)

Response/update: Current phase of works to be implemented in 2011/12 Capital Programme. Anticipated to commence first quarter.

5) Traffic Management Agency Programme 2010/11 – concern expressed about parking at 4 schools in Andover thus making it unsafe for dropping children at schools. The need to make sure there are enough Enforcement Officers to enforce the area before 9am (page 4).

Response/update: The TRO covering all existing School Keep Clears in Test Valley has progressed to the point where the objection period has closed. Two objections were received in relation to just one School in Andover. We are awaiting a response from the School which we expect next week when they return from half term. If successful the Order will be confirmed and works ordered. I would anticipate the works to be implemented by 1/9/11.

6) To include St Johns Cross roundabout in the Capital and Study Programme for 2011/12 (page 5)

Response/update: No funding identified for a scheme in this location.

7) In relation to Traffic Management Programme 2011/12, to include the Gateway at St John's Cross in the list of projects to be reviewed (page 5) .

Response/update: St John's Cross has been added as a location to be investigated in the provisional 11/12 Traffic Management Programme.

8) The issue of excess signs, particularly redundant signs in Hurstbourne Tarrant (page 6).

Response/update: Order has been raised for the removal of the redundant signs in Hurstbourne Tarrant
