

**MATTERS ARISING FROM BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE HAT HIGHWAYS MEETING HELD ON 26 OCTOBER 2010**

1) Cllr Still requested that someone speak to the HAT about the process of road adoptions (page 2).

**Response/update:** A briefing note is attached to act as an 'aide memoire' for future reference for Members.

2) Public consultation in Laverstoke with regard to speed reduction (page 2).

**Response/update:** This has not been prioritised for 2011/12 traffic management programme. It will be considered for inclusion in 2012/13 programme.

3) Thornhill Way, Chineham (page 2) - cars overtaking the school bus.

**Response/update:** Barry Ford has investigated this matter. A response is included in the updated list of issues (see Item 4).

4) Old Kempshott Lane (page 3) Plans have been sent to Cllr Reid regarding the Old Kempshott Lane scheme.

**Response/update:** Plans have been sent to Cllr Reid and further discussions have been held with him. The majority of his concerns have been overcome and he now supports the scheme's proposals.

5) North Popley school crossing patrol officer (page 3).

**Response/update:** On the school crossing patrol issue the County Council's school crossing patrol team has been asked to investigate. A survey will be undertaken to assess the level of pedestrian activity. If the criteria is met, based on this survey, a school crossing patrol officer post will be advertised which local people can apply for if they are keen to assist in road safety.

6) Minor works programme (page 4). Peter Eade to further consult with Members on their preferred schemes.
