1. The decision:

1.1. That Lynch Hill Park/Dances Lane be included in the 20mph speed limit proposals for the Whitchurch Residential 20mph pilot scheme when they are formally advertised as part of the Traffic Order process.

2. Reason for the decision:

2.1. Given the expressions of interest received from a large number of residents residing on Lynch Hill Park in favour of its inclusion in the 20mph trial, it is sensible to include this location within the proposals to be formally advertised for public comment.

3. Other options considered and rejected:

3.1. The option to continue to formal advertisement without the inclusion of Lynch Hill Park/Dances Lane was considered and rejected. It is clear that if this option were to be pursued there would be considerable comment received during the advertising period requesting inclusion of these roads. These comments would have to be formally considered and, if upheld at that stage, would result in the need to re-advertise any revised proposals.
