#### 1. The decision:

- a) That the Project Appraisal for the provision of new pedestrian and cycle infrastructure within the Segensworth business areas, near Fareham, at an estimated cost of £265,000 be approved.
- b) That the new section of shared use footway/cycleway be incorporated into the Highway network under Section 65 and Section 66 of the Highways Act 1980.

#### 2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. The scheme will provide a new shared use footway/cycleway linking Little Park Farm Road in Segensworth West with Brunel Way in Segensworth East and provide a quiet route for pedestrians and cyclists to access the business areas, as an alternative to traversing the busy A27 Segensworth roundabout. Future schemes, subject to funding, aim to connect this section of cycleway towards the Park Gate area and the Swanwick Railway Station beyond.
- 2.2. The new footways in Barnes Wallis Road and Brunel Way in Segensworth East, will improve pedestrian facilities where there are currently only grass verges.
- 2.3 The proposed footway link between Barnes Wallis Road and Jacaranda Close will form a pedestrian link to the existing bus stops located on Segensworth Road, and thus improve accessibility and travel choices for the employees and visitors to the Segensworth business areas.
- 2.4 The proposals support the Corporate aims:
  - (i) making Hampshire safer and more secure for all;

- (ii) maximising well-being; and
- (iii) enhancing our quality of place.

**3. Other options considered and rejected:**

3.1. The proposals have emerged directly from the Segensworth Action Plan 2010, which takes the form of a transport strategy document that sets out how access to the employment opportunities in the Segensworth business areas can be improved.
