#### 1. The decision:

1.1. That £5,800 of funding be awarded to Knightwood Youth Club via the Hampshire Action Team for Test Valley, to support the set up costs of a new Youth Club in Valley Park, for 2010/11 only, with no expectation of funding for future years.

#### 2. Reason(s) for the decision:

2.1 Valley Park is a relatively affluent area, but has a history of alcohol misuse and low level anti social behaviour amongst its young people. Knightwood Youth Club will actively encourage healthy life styles for the young people resident in Valley Park. Specifically, the project will focus on education against alcohol and substance misuse, smoking and inappropriate sexual behaviour. There is an absence of suitable youth provision for our target group in the area, hence the need for raising the financial support necessary to create a youth club of the kind proposed. The project will help to address specific LAA priorities Theme A, Children and young people, Theme E, Safer communities, Theme F, Health and wellbeing and Theme H, Strong communities; Improve community engagement.
