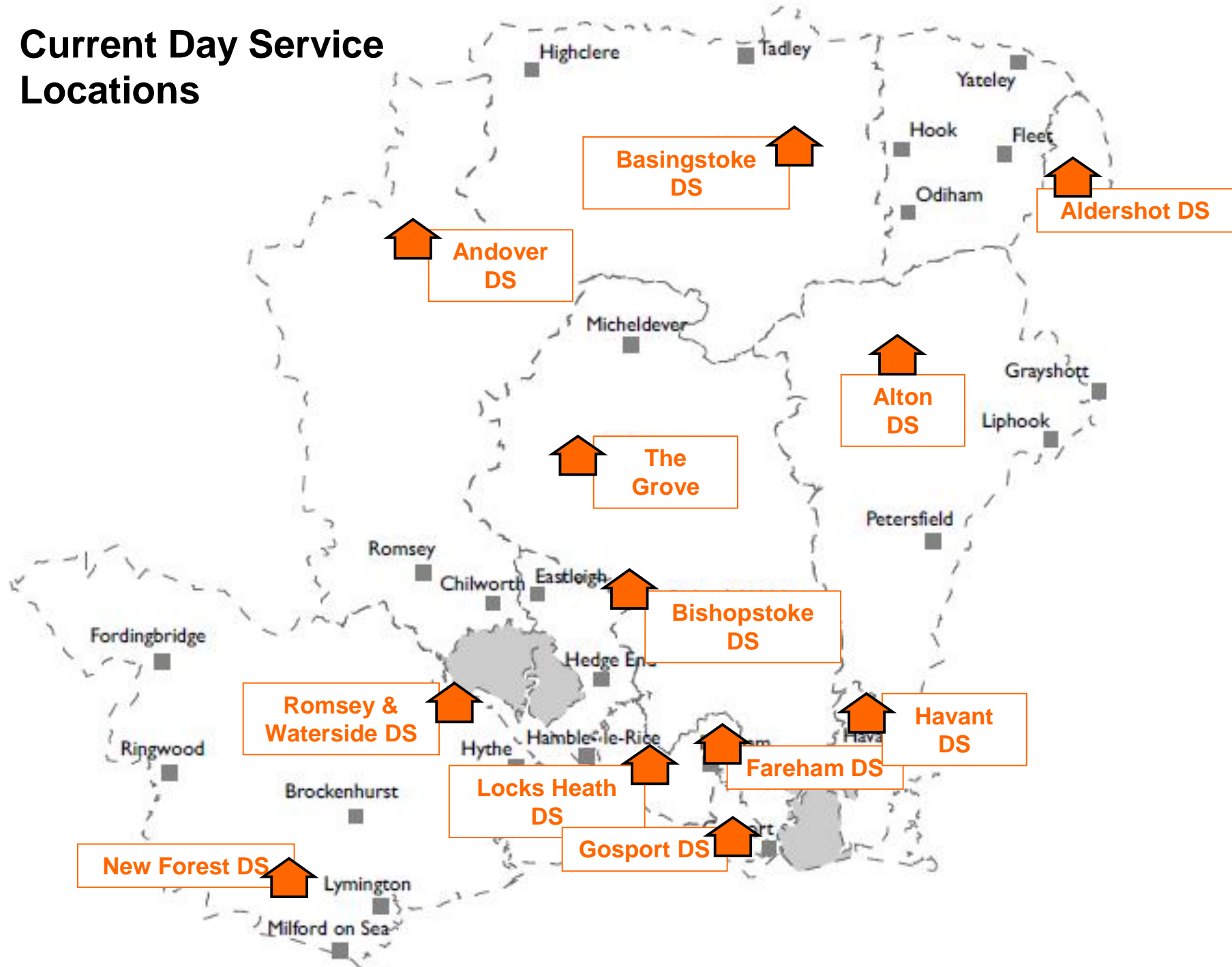

# Background

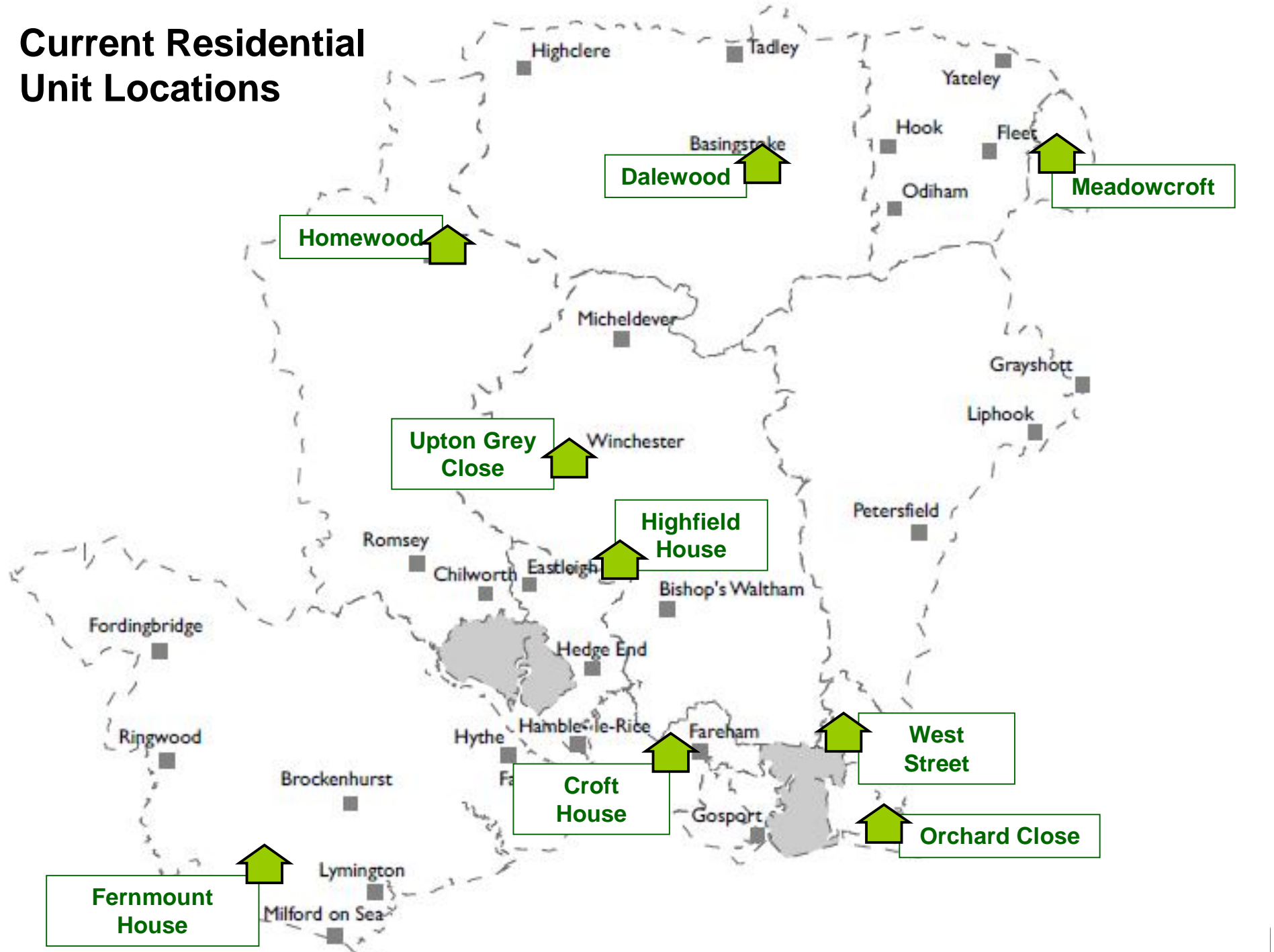
The Council owns:

# Current Residential Unit Locations








# Aims of Transformation are modernisation and improvement

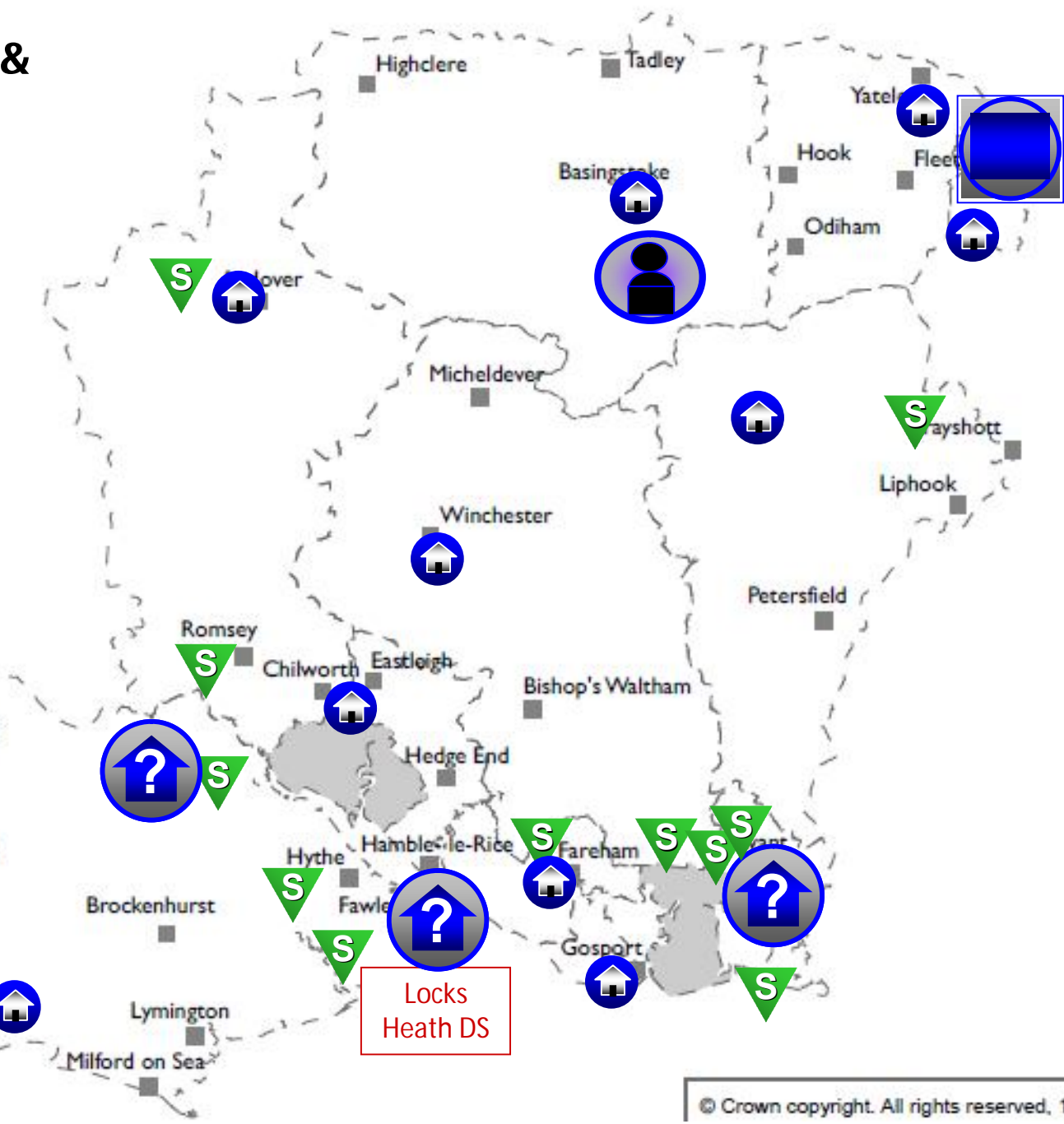
- Offering more choice for people with learning disabilities
- Offering more day opportunities in the community
- Improving facilities for people with complex needs
- Making services more attractive so that people continue to choose them
- Matching services with current and future demand
- Making services efficient and therefore sustainable
- Maintaining and improving services rather than cutting them

# Day Service Recommendations

- Enhancing services for people with complex needs with enhanced facilities (Keystone Services) in Havant with Locks Heath with a newly built service in Totton
- Providing smaller community bases (Community Link Services) closer to community facilities
- Increasing choice of alternatives to traditional day services
- Changing Basingstoke and Bishopstoke Day Services first
- Maintaining current satellite services

-  Commissioned service with enhanced facilities



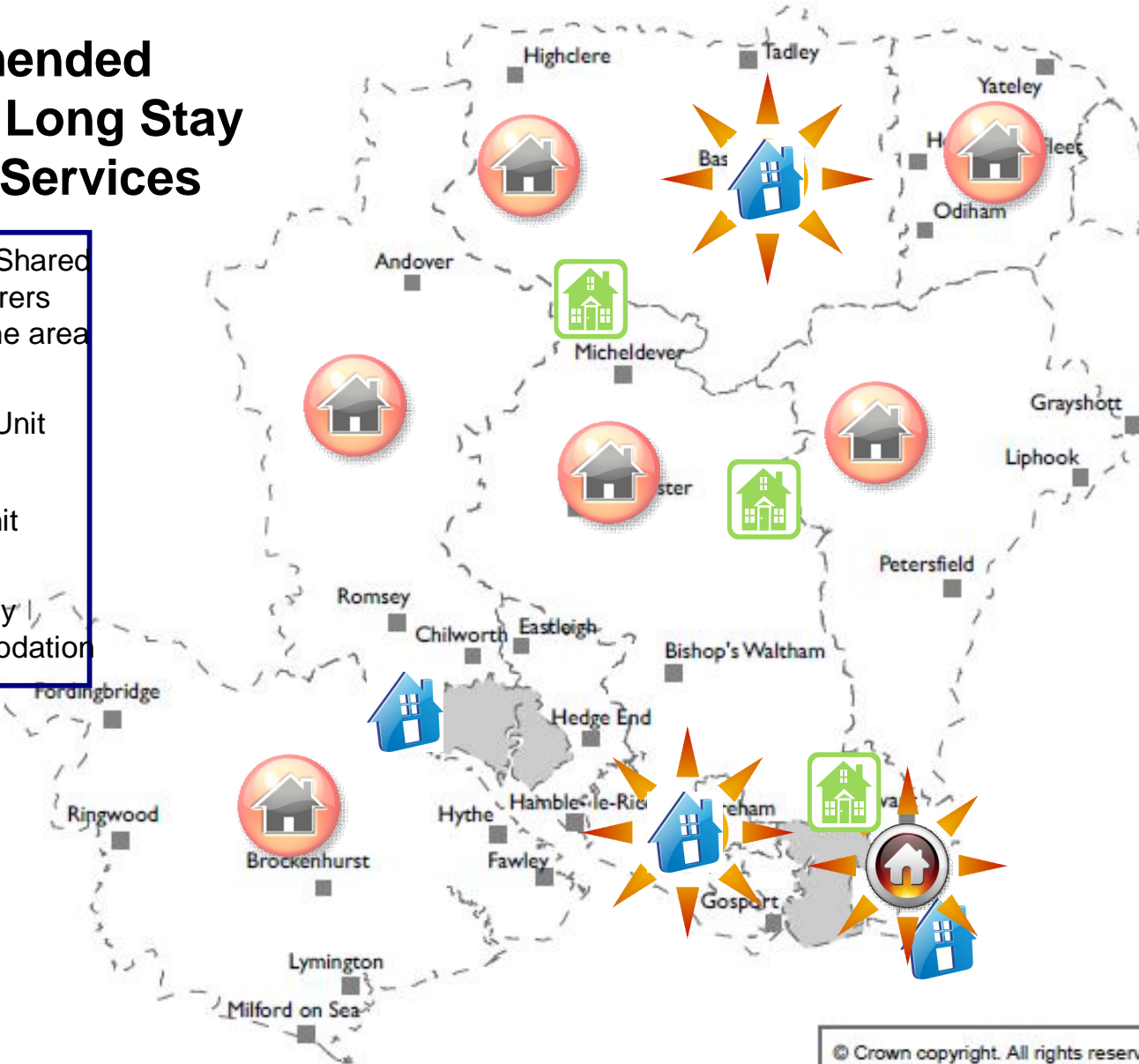
# Residential Recommendations

- That enhanced residential respite facilities for people with complex needs be built in Basingstoke and Fareham
- That crisis, long stay care and respite do not happen in the same home
- Matching capacity of respite beds to future demand
- Development of alternatives to residential respite
- Development of a new model of crisis
- Exploring other models of support for those living in residential care
