Title of Bid/ Project	Morgan's Organs
Summary of Bid/ Project	<p>A PHSE (Personal Health and Social Education) based drama project aimed to combat Childhood Obesity and promote Healthy Eating and Exercise. The project would be to be delivered initially to children for up to 3 project days in Primary and Junior Schools in East Hampshire</p> <p>The Phoenix Theatre Company will engage Arts professionals to work with children during the school day with the <i>Morgan's Organs</i> drama project.</p> <p>The project features a large colourful character called Morgan. Each one of Morgan's organs takes on a character, for example Harriet Heart, Lily Liver and Stanley Stomach and many more. Children are able to participate in interactive drama workshops to explore the characteristics of each organ and what each one requires to sustain a healthy body. The workshops stimulate learning and encourage healthy eating and exercise.</p> <p>Workshops would run for 1 hour each throughout the school day and would be suitable for years 3 upwards. The project will give the children the best possible start in life with an awareness of how to look after themselves sustaining healthy bodies</p> <p>The Theatre Company could work with 4 groups of up to 30 children in one school day = 120 children per day. A Total of 360 children could participate in this project.</p> <p>Research shows that no other similar project is currently running in East Hampshire which encourages children to lead healthy lifestyles, adding to their general well being.</p>

An Evaluation report will be produced after the end of the project and will build into future planning for further sessions.</p> <p>The project will be internally assessed by the Phoenix Project Manager and verified by the Learning & Development Manager at Community First East Hampshire. Evaluation forms and observation of drama performance will be used in an evaluation report.</p> <p>Evaluation forms will be given to the key staff in each school and to individual pupils. Evidence in the form of photographs will be used, where permission is granted in line with the Phoenix Child Protection Policy.</p>
Future Funding Arrangements (If the project is to last more than a year how will it be funded in subsequent years? How will any outcomes achieved by the project be sustained in the longer term? It is hoped that funding would be available from various sources such as local councils, trusts/foundations or Arts Funding bodies for subsequent years. It could be expected that there would be a contribution from participating schools.
