1. The decision:

- a) That unconditional approval be given to the following proposal, published by Hampshire County Council under Section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006:

To make prescribed alterations to Norwood Primary School, Chamberlayne Road, Eastleigh, Hampshire SO50 5JL (category – community) by enlarging the school premises with effect from 1 September 2015.

2. Reason(s) for the decision:

- 2.1. Following local consultation, Hampshire County Council published a Public Notice to enlarge the school premises of Norwood Primary School from 210 places to 420 places with effect from 1 September 2015.
- 2.2. The Public Notice was published on 2 May 2014. The County Council complied with all statutory requirements relating to the publication of the Public Notice.
- 2.3. In accordance with the procedure approved by Cabinet on 21 May 2007 power to allow the Director of Children's Services to make a decision on an enlargement proposal can only take place if there are no objections to the proposal. One objection was raised and three comments were received about car parking.

- 3.1. Not to approve the proposal would mean that there are insufficient places in the area for primary school age.
