1. The decision:

- 1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be to reduce the following lengths of road from the national speed limit to 30 miles per hour:
- (i) U256 Tangier Park Lane between its junction with C123 Ibworth Lane and a point 310 metres west thereof.
 - (ii) C123 Ibworth Lane between a point 313 metres east of its junction with U252 Wootton One Mile and a point 472 metres north thereof.
 - (iii) U252 Wootton One Mile between its junction with C123 Ibworth Lane and a point 378 metres south-west thereof.

2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. No objections or representations were received in response to the public consultation which took place between 23 October and 13 November 2015.
- 2.2. The proposal is to reduce the current national speed limit throughout the specified area of the village of Wootton St. Lawrence to a 30 miles per hour speed limit. A speed survey was carried out and showed that the average speeds of vehicles throughout the village are suited to a 30 miles per hour limit. The Parish Council originally raised the idea and this scheme has since received the backing of the County Councillor for the area, as well as Hampshire Constabulary.
