### 1. The decision:

- 1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be to impose a 50 miles per hour speed limit (currently de-restricted) on that length of A272 London Road / Midhurst Road between a point 125 metres south-east of its junction with B2070 London Road (i.e. the termination of the existing 50mph), and a point 885 metres south-east of that point.

*The order will revoke and re-enact the provisions contained in an existing order with no change of substance save for the addition above.*

### 2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. No objections or representations were received in response to the public consultation which took place between 29 April and 23 May 2016.
- 2.2. The proposed changes in the speed limits will help to reduce personal injury accidents and promote road safety while also making the speed limits more appropriate for the nature and environment of the road.
