- 1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be to revoke the existing prohibition of right turn manoeuvres and allow vehicles travelling on Oakridge Road to make a right turn into Sherborne Road at Basingstoke.

#### 2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. No objections or representations were received in response to the public consultation which took place between 5 September 2014 and 26 September 2014.
- 2.2 The proposal is made in response to concerns raised by the ward councillors that drivers were not obeying the prohibition and buses no longer turn into Sherborne Road. The proposal has the support of the County Councillor for the area.


