1. The decision:

- 1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be to impose a 30 miles per hour speed limit (existing 40mph limit) on the A343 Salisbury Road between a point 220 metres south-west of its junction with C7 Farley Street (as measured from the eastern kerbline) and a point 340 metres north-east of that point.
- 1.2. The order will also revoke and re-enact the provisions contained in an existing order with no change of substance save for the change described above.

2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. No objections or representations were received in response to the public consultation which took place between 15 January and 5 February 2016.
- 2.2. As a result of the Countywide A & B Roads speed limit review, a number of sections of road have been identified as having an excessively high collision rate occurring along their length.

Given the varied nature of each road it is therefore proposed to reduce the speed on each road as necessary, in order to reduce the accident rate and increase overall safety.

Traffic speed surveys undertaken within the proposed 30 mph limits along the A343 recorded mean average speeds which ranged between 35.0 and 38.7 mph.


