1. The decision:

- 1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be to impose a 50mph speed limit (currently de-restricted) on that length of C330 Stockbridge Road East (known locally as Cranbourne road), between a point 402 metres north-east of its junction with the A30 Bullington Lane and a point 105 metres north-east of its junction with the access road leading to Norton Park Hotel, an approximate distance of 1505 metres.

The order will also revoke and re-enact the provisions contained in The Hampshire (Various Roads, Sutton Scotney/Wonston) (Restricted Road and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2001 with no change of substance, save for the addition described above.

2. Reason(s) for the decision:

- 2.1. No objections or representations were received in response to the public consultation which took place between 22 May and 15 June 2015.
- 2.2. The proposal is made in response to the general public concern raised for traffic safety and the Parish request for a transitional speed limit between the national speed limit and the 40mph on the C330 in Sutton Scotney
