<b>Title:</b>	Traffic Order Proposals – No Waiting at Any Time in Camp Road, Gosport
<b>Reference:</b>	

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#### 1. The decision:

1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be to impose no waiting at any time on the following lengths of road in the Camp Road area, Gosport:

- (i) **Camp Road (eastern section), south side** – between a point 38 metres west of its junction with A32 Fareham Road and a point 71 metres west thereof.
- (ii) **Camp Road (western section), both sides** – between its junction with Bridgemary Avenue/Braemar Road and a point 10 metres west thereof.
- (iii) **Bridgemary Avenue, west side** – between the centreline of its junction with Camp Road and a point 17 metres north thereof.
- (iv) **Braemar Road, west side** – between the centreline of its junction with Camp Road and a point 17 metres south thereof.

1.2. The order will also regularise, consolidate and re-enact the provisions contained in two existing orders.

#### 2. Reasons for the decision:

2.1. No objections were received in response to the public consultation which took place between 17 July and 7 August 2015.

2.2. Planning permission has been granted to develop the Pooles Peugeot garage site on the south side of Camp Road, between A32 Fareham Road and Wavell Road.

2.3. Included within the new residential development is the provision of two vehicle access points. Waiting restrictions in the form of double yellow lines are required to maintain visibility for/of vehicles emerging from the new access points and a Traffic Regulation Order for this was approved

through a Section 106 agreement as part of the planning permissions for this development.

2.4. Whilst considering this Traffic Regulation Order, there is an opportunity to rationalise existing Orders on Camp Road and rectify some small anomalies, mainly the provision of double yellow lines at the junction where the western section of Camp Road meets Bridgemary Avenue and Braemar Road. Advisory white lines currently cover this side of the crossroads junction and so it is intended to provide double yellow lines to a similar extent as the existing restrictions on the opposite side.
