### 1. The decision:

1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of road at Gosport:

#### ***B3333 Privett Road – south side***

- (i) between a point 16 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Oval Gardens and a point 34 metres east of that point.
- (ii) between a point 54 metres east of the centre line of its junction with Oval Gardens and a point 28 metres east of that point.

#### ***B3333 Privett Road – north side***

- (i) between a point 70 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Woodward Close and a point 37 metres west of that point.
- (ii) between a point 12 metres west of the centre line of its junction with the service road situated between property nos. 84 and 86 Privett Road and a point 32.5 metres east of that point.

#### ***Oval Gardens - both sides***

Between its junction with B3333 Privett Road and a point 10 metres south thereof.

#### ***Service road situated between property nos. 70 and 72 Privett Road – both sides***

Between its junction with B3333 Privett Road and a point 10 metres north thereof.

#### ***Service road situated between property nos. 84 and 86 Privett Road – both sides***

Between its junction with B3333 Privett Road and a point 10 metres north thereof.

*In addition the order will also revoke and re-enact the provisions contained in an existing order with no change of substance save for the addition of the above.*

## **2. Reason(s) for the decision:**

- 2.1. No objections were received in response to the public consultation which took place between 18 March and 11 April 2016. Two representations were received from local residents, both asking for the proposed restrictions to be extended. However, this has been discussed further with both residents individually and the potentially negative impact of further loss of parking has been explained. Neither resident has subsequently progressed their enquiry to a formal objection.
- 2.2. In view of ongoing concerns about parking at or near side road junctions on Privett Road, it is intended to implement new waiting restrictions as shown on drawing no. 242/1146 to help ease access problems and improve safety.

The two access roads north of Oval Gardens junction (one opposite 97 and the other opposite 109 Privett Road) leading to Privett Park and the traffic island opposite 70 Privett Road are also being considered for waiting restrictions, as they are currently unprotected and may be vulnerable to parking displacement from Oval Gardens.

The proposals are consistent with existing restrictions at Charlesbury Avenue and improves the amenity and highway safety around the areas concerned.
