1. The decision:

- 1.1. That a Traffic Order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to reduce the existing 40 mph speed limit on Satchell Lane between its junction with Mursell Way and a point 106 metres north of its junction with St. Agatha's Road, an approximate distance of 1,473 metres.

2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. A 30 mph speed limit is proposed to reflect the changing character of the area which serves a community college, sports facilities, a health centre, grazed fields and residential properties.

Satchell Lane accommodates a mix of road users, including a reasonable level of vulnerable road users (pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians) at the northern extent which is served by a cycle and footway facility. The road geometry with bends and narrow road widths naturally limits traffic speeds to a level appropriate for a 30 mph speed limit.

- (ii) The Borough of Eastleigh (Satchell Lane, Hamble-le-Rice) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2008.
