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### 1. The decision:

1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be direct that traffic travelling in any of the lanes specified below at the Black Dam Roundabout shall not proceed in a direction other than that specified:

- (i) **A30 London Road**, lanes 3 and 4, westbound – ahead only into Black Dam Roundabout central carriageway (westbound spur).
- (ii) **Link road leading from the M3 motorway**, lanes 3, 4, 5 and 6, northbound – ahead only into Black Dam central carriageway (northbound).
- (iii) **Black Dam Roundabout**, central carriageway, all lanes, northbound – ahead only Black Dam Roundabout central carriageway (northbound).
- (iv) **Black Dam Roundabout**, central carriageway, all lanes, northbound – ahead only into A339 Ringway East.
- (v) **Black Dam Roundabout**, central carriageway (westbound spur), both lanes – ahead only into Black Dam Roundabout central carriageway (eastbound).
- (vi) **A30 Ringway South**, lanes 3, 4 and 5, eastbound – ahead only into Black Dam Roundabout orbital carriageway (westbound).
- (vii) **Black Dam Roundabout**, orbital carriageway, both lanes, northbound – Ahead only into Black Dam Roundabout orbital carriageway (eastbound).
- (viii) **Black Dam Roundabout**, orbital carriageway, all lanes, westbound – ahead only into Black Dam Roundabout orbital carriageway, northbound and / or A30 Ringway South.
- (ix) **Black Dam Roundabout**, orbital carriageway, lanes, 3, 4 and 5, eastbound – ahead only into Black Dam Roundabout orbital carriageway, southbound and / or A30 London Road.

**2. Reason(s) for the decision:**

- 2.1. No objections or representations were received in response to the public consultation which took place between 29 January and 19 February 2016.
- 2.2. The proposed prescribed routes are required for the safe and efficient operation of the traffic signals at the roundabout junction
