#### 1. The decision:

- 1.1. That a Traffic Order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to modify the existing 30 mph speed limit on B3079 by extending it in a northerly direction between a point 60 metres north-west of its junction with B3078 Roger Penny Way and a point approximately 255 metres north-west thereof.
- 1.2 The order will also revoke and re-enact the provisions contained in several existing orders with no change of substance save for the addition of the restrictions described above.

#### 2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. The proposal comes in response to calls from the County Councillor and the Parish Council to link the two 30 mph speed limit sections on B3079 by reducing the existing 40 mph speed limit in the middle section.

The proposal, which will have the effect of enhancing safety along the route and particularly in light of the frequent accidents involving animals, has the support of the Police, the Parish Council and the local Member.

The Hampshire (Various Roads, New Forest North) (40 Miles per Hour Speed Limit) Order 1990 *insofar as it relates to item (2) of the schedule i.e. B3079.*
