1. The decision:

- 1.1. That a traffic order be implemented under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effects of which will be prohibit vehicles from driving in that length of un-named access road leading to the Abbotswood development between its junction with Woodley Lane and a point 39 metres north thereof. Exemptions will be included for buses, pedal cycles and emergency service vehicles.
- 1.2. Following comments made by Test Valley Borough Council during the formal consultation, the draft order has been revised to include an exemption for maintenance vehicles.

2. Reasons for the decision:

- 2.1. No objections or representations were received in response to the public consultation which took place between 10 July and 31 July 2015.
- 2.2. A bus route is being developed to serve the Abbotswood development in Romsey. There is a demand for the bus service and the development has reached a stage where the service is needed. Implementation of this Traffic Order will enable the bus service to serve the whole development, entering the development at Woodley Lane through the bus gate and then leaving the development via Braishfield Road.
